Swing Carriage - The load capacity of a lift truck jib has a most of around 1935 lbs to 6000 pounds on either the retracted or extended positions range. Before using a lift truck jib, make certain that it is correctly secured to the forklift with the use of hooks and shackles. Always double check to be able to verify that the screw pins are tight. Keep in mind to take into consideration the truth that rated capacities occasionally decrease when the boom is in a raised position, each time the boom is extended with telehandlers or whenever the mast is tilted forward.

Vital suggestions whenever making use of an adjustable jib is not to ever pull a load utilizing this sort of accessory. These kinds of additions are just used for vertical raising. Moreover, refrain from letting the load swing. Use extreme caution each time a load is carried in order to avoid tipping over the truck.
